Activities / June 6-8, 2008

Location: Malakoff Diggins State Historic Park, about 45 minutes from Nevada City in the Sierras (See map at FremontMen.org)

Elevation: About 4000 ft

Points of Interest, Things to do:

- Explore the ghost town of North Bloomfield, including the school, church, drug store, hotel, saloon, livery stable, and other buildings
- Join in old fashion fun at Humbug Day on Saturday--see the ghost town come alive!
- Explore geologic wonders of the world's largest hydraulic gold mine
- Explore a mining tunnel (bring your flashlight)
- Pan for gold in Humbug Creek
- Fish for trout in Humbug Creek or the South Fork of the Yuba River
- Hike numerous trails through beautiful forests with great scenery
- Swim (and fish for bass and bluegill) at Blair Lake
- Enjoy campfire programs, weenie roasts and great fellowship
- Tent camp in our own private group campground
- Dine on meals cooked in the great outdoors.
- Deer, raccoon, opossum, rabbits, birds and many other animals are common in the park.
